What is Kan Ha Diskan and Breton dancing songs?

Kan-ha-Diskan is a popular Breton singing style often heard during Fest-Noz (dancing nights). The exceptional rhythmic format of the songs featuring singing (Kan) and replies (Diskan) is extremely effective for dancing. While very ancient, it is permanently revisited and revived by numerous artists (Denez Prigent/Alan Stivell/ Yann-Fanch Kemener).
